Fear creates distance and walls	Courageous inquiry fosters understanding
Win-lose mindset	Win-win mindset in holding all needs with care
Become the victim and avoid the issue	Empower oneself and explore assumptions
Judge, shame and blame	Discern and empathize with an open heart
Talk first, think second, feel last	Feel first, think second, talk last
Attack and defend speaking	Build trust by speaking authentically
Listen by thinking of a response	Listen by uncovering feelings and needs
Make demands – focus on goals	Make promises and requests – balance process with goals
Confrontation – attached to a position	Carefrontation – co-create new outcomes
I'm right - You're wrong	I'm OK - You're OK
Relationship connection compromised	Relationship connection strengthens
